School Closure

Dear Parents/Carers,

From today our school will be closed for normal business until further notice.

We will be offering child care for Key Workers and Vulnerable children from Monday. This child care offer is open to eligible Key Workers, we are asking parents to only use this service when you have no alternative child care available. On Monday school will be open from 8.15am (no breakfast club) children don't need to wear uniform as we hope to have some sessions outside - please dress appropriately. Everyone is being asked to limit social contact and unnecessary travel and school staff are voluntarily coming in to provide this service. (Please, can any Key Workers complete a form and return it to the office)

The Government have announced meal/voucher plans for those eligible for Free School Meals - at the moment we have little information about how this will look. We will be contacting these families today to share some ideas for next week. If you haven't received a text from school but think you are eligible please get in touch on Monday.

We are all dealing with new challenges and worries on a daily basis, I'm so proud of our staff who are working so hard to support our Key Workers with childcare and provide work for those pupils who will be at home. If your child is not in school please keep them at home, the school closures are there to limit contact with others and try to stop the spread of this virus. When we hear about school re-opening we will be in touch

We'll keep in touch with you through text, email and Dojo in the coming weeks and months. We'll also keep the school website updated (News and Parents sections)

Please take care and be kind to one another and remember as long as school is open we will be at the end of a phone is you have concerns.
